Notes: Daniel Blandford

Daniel owned the schooner Tatler, built in Twillingate in 1820 and registered in 1831. He also owned the schooner Elizabeth, built in Green Bay in 1838 and lost at sea in 1884. He also owned the schooner Britannica, built in Green Bay in 1860 and lost at sea in Frenchman's Harbour in 1899, and the schooner Lady Jane, built in Green Bay in 1849.

At the time of the 1836 census. The composition of Daniel's household at this census is very interesting, as it shows 3 men aged 14-60. Daniel would have been one, but who were the other two?

Daniel donated 2 months of labour to the Church Society (for the benefit of Newfoundland poor) in 1849. He was living in Salt Harbour Island.

Daniel was a planter in Herring Neck in 1871, per Lovell's.

Daniel died April 22, 1879 per his headstone.
