Charles Henry Hall (born 24th April 1809) and **Ann Catherine** ((born 3rd September 1808), eldest daughter of **C.M. Litteljohn**, were married at Hope Park in the Parish of St Andrew on the 17th day of July 1832, by the **Rev A. Campbell**.

Their children as follows, viz:-

- 1. **Flora Eliza** was born on the 21st day of June, 1833, and died on the 4th day of July 1834. Interred in Half way Tree Churchyard.
- 2. **Charlianna Sophia** was born at Halfway Tree on 28th day of May 1835, at 10 o'clock in the morning. Sponsors: **Miss Osborne Isabella Hall** and **D. R. Litteljohn**. Baptized by the Rev. A. Campbell. Married to **Dr. Croskery** on 19th July 1859.
- 3. **Charles William Henry**, born 11th February, 1837. Baptized March following at Halfway Tree Church. Sponsors: **Caroline Litteljohn** and the Rev. Messrs **John Magrath** and **C. F. Hall**. Died 24th October 1891. Buried at Halfway Tree Churchyard 25th October 1891.
- 4. **Caleb Litteljohn**, born at the Parsonage, St Johns, on 12th May 1838. Baptized in January 1839 at Halfway Tree Church, St Andrew by the Rev. A. Campbell. Sponsors: **C. M. Littlejohn**, **Edward Litteljohn** and **Mrs H. S. Isaacs**, married **Kathleen Hamilton**, 6th December 1870. Died 16th June 1900 (1899?). Buried Halfway Tree Churchyard.
- 5. **David Baillie**, born 29th August 1839, at the Parsonage, St Johns. Baptized on 25th December the same year at Lluidas Vale Chapel by the **Rev. C. H. Hall**. Sponsors: **Mr. & Mrs Lash** and the **Rev. D. R. Litteljohn**.
- 6. **Edward Hamilton**, born 4th December 1840, at the Parsonage, St Johns. Baptized on the 11th April 1841 at Lluidas Vale Chapel, by the **Rev. C. H. Hall**. Sponsors: **Mr. & Mrs. Hamilton** and **Rev. D. R. Litteljohn**. Married 1st July 1874 to **Sarah Ann Hamilton**. Died 28th August 1880. Buried at Halfway Tree Churchyard 29th August 1880.
- 7. **Elizabeth Caroline**, born 12th July 1842, at the Parsonage. Baptized at Lluidas Vale Chapel on 31st July following by **Rev. C. H. Hall**. Sponsors: **Mr & Mrs Lash** and **Miss Litteljohn**.
- 8. **Mary Octavia**, born 12th July 1843, at Content Penn, St Andrew. Baptized at the parish Church by the **Rev. Alexander Campbell** the 13th August following. Sponsors: **Miss Donaldson, Miss Garcia** and **D. R. Litteljohn**. Died 25th September 1846 at Pleasant prospect, buried in Halfway Tree Churchyard.
- 9. **George Nicholas**, born 25th November 1844, at the Parsonage, St Johns. Baptized at St John's Chaple. Lluidas Vale on 6th April 1845. Sponsors: **George Price, Emily Price** and **D. R. Litteljohn**. (Died in Spanish Town on the buried in Halfway Tree Churchyard).
- 10. **Emily**, born at Pleasant Prospect February 16th 1846. Baptized at Halfway Tree Church, St Andrew, 16th April 1846. Sponsors: **Mr & Mrs Thomas Heath** and **Miss Helen Josselyn**. Married **Dr. Goodman** of the Navy May 8th 1866. (*Died at Hove, Sussex, England on and cremated at Woking on the*).

Sponsors: **Charlianna Sophia Hall**, her sister, **Caroline Mary Lash**, her cousin, and **Charles W. H. Hall**, her brother. Married 7th January 1879 to **C. C. Aitken, Esq.**

Charles Hall of Kingston, Merchant, was born at Preston, Lancashire (Eng) on 25th December 1729, and was married on 26th August 1758 to **Ann Pickering Bickerstaff**, daughter of **Edmund** and **Elizabeth Bickerstaff** of the Parish of Kingston, Jamaica, who died on 29th September following aged 18 years 1 month and 11 days, and was buried in the Church at Kingston. On 30th September, 1760, the said Charles Hall was married (again) to **Elizabeth Boone**, daughter of the **Honourable Henry Boone** of the Parish of St Andrew, Jamaica, and **Mary** his then wife, now the wife of **Daniel Grant** of the parish of St Ann, by whom he had issue the following sons and daughters:

- 1. **Elizabeth Mary**, born 12th December 1761, died unmarried at Snowdon in the Prish of Manchester on day 1843, aged 82 years.
- 2. **Christiana Sophia**, born 30th September 1763. Married **Captain Manley Dixon** of the RN and died in England.
- 3. **Charles William,** born died at Pleasant Prospect, St Andrew 1832 aged years. (*This is Rev C. H. Hall's father*).
