

THE DESCENDANTS OF HUGH CROSKERY (b. 1803) OF DOWNPATRICK

1. HUGH¹ CROSKERY was born 1803 in Downpatrick, County Down, [Northern] Ireland^{1,2}. He married CHARLOTTE WALLACE BROWN 9 May 1834 in or near Ballynahinch, County Down, [Northern] Ireland². She was born in or lived at Roundhill, near Ballynahinch, County Down, [Northern] Ireland^{3,4}.

Notes for HUGH CROSKERY:

Hugh and Charlotte were married by the Reverend John Shaw of Magheradrool, Minister from 1831 to 1870 of the First Presbyterian Church of Ballynahinch.[a] The Reverend Mr. Shaw was also the minister who married Grace Shaw and Robert Croskery at the Ballynahinch First Presbyterian Church in 1850[b] (see in the Crosgrove chapter).

2. THE REVEREND HUGH² CROSKERY, M.D., PRIEST, OF INCH AND JAMAICA (*HUGH*¹) was born 13 January 1835 in Inch, County Down, [Northern] Ireland^{19,20,21}, and died 1886 in Demerara, British Guiana²¹. He married CHARLIANNA SOPHIA [ELEANOR?] HALL^{22,23} 19 July 1859 in Clarendon, Jamaica^{24,25}, daughter of CHARLES HALL and ANN LITTLEJOHN. She was born about 1840.

Notes for THE REVEREND HUGH CROSKERY, M.D., PRIEST, OF INCH AND JAMAICA:

The Reverend Dr Hugh Croskery, MRCSI, JP, RN, studied medicine and received a medical degree. Thereafter, he served as a Naval Surgeon in the British Navy.[a] Later, in 1859,[b] Hugh moved to Jamaica where he took the position of a District Medical Officer. After studying for the ministry, he was ordained an Anglican priest.

Hugh's wife, Charlianna Sophia Hall ("Eleanor" Hall according to one source), was the daughter of The Reverend Charles Henry Hall, an Anglican priest, and Ann Catherine Litteljohn.

At his death, Hugh was buried in the family cemetery at Half Way Tree, Kingston, Jamaica.[a, b, c] In the following excerpt, H.P. Jacobs gave an account about Hugh in a broadcast on RJR (Radio Jamaica, Ltd.) on 1 November 1966:[d]

"There is no trace now of the old house at 85 East Street, where today you will find a new building occupied by Reckitt & Coleman (Overseas) Ltd. But the old

building was occupied nearly a century ago by someone whose name will perhaps have an oddly familiar ring for you.

"The Rev. Hugh Croskery died at the age of 51, but almost everything about his not very long life was unusual, including his death. Croskery was an Irishman, an Ulsterman, born in 1835. He started as a naval surgeon, of all things, and on the strength of a Medical degree became a District Medical Officer in Jamaica. That was as early as 1857, and he stayed many years at Chapelton, where he married the daughter of the Rev. Charles Hall, who was at Chapelton for a quarter of a century. In 1871 he became an Anglican deacon and served at Chapelton as curate to his father-in-law. He continued to practice as a doctor and is about the nearest I can find to a medical missionary in Jamaica. He wrote a book, "The Gospel of the Kingdom", which was published in 1877 and he also became a priest."

THE REV. DR. HUGH CROSKERY

There is no trace now of the old house at 85 East Street, where today you will find a new building occupied by Reckitt & Coleman (Overseas) Ltd. But the old building was occupied nearly a century ago by someone whose name will perhaps have an oddly familiar ring for you.

The Rev. Hugh Croskery died at the age of 51, but almost everything about his not very long life was unusual, including his death. Croskery was an Irishman, an Ulsterman, born in 1835. He started as a naval surgeon, of all things, and on the strength of a Medical degree became a District Medical Officer in Jamaica. That was as early as 1857, and he stayed many years at Chapelton, where he married the daughter of the Rev. Charles Hall, who was at Chapelton for a quarter of a century. In 1871 he became an Anglican deacon and served at Chapelton as curate to his father-in-law. He continued to practice as a doctor and is about the nearest I can find to a medical missionary in Jamaica. Notes for CHARLES CROSKERY:

In July 1894, Charles sailed on the "S.S. State of Nebraska" from Glasgow, Scotland, to (apparently) New York, arriving there on 17 July 1894. Then on 7 October 1913, Charles sailed aboard the "S.S. Obidense" from Kingston, Jamaica, with his nephew and niece and their nurse, arriving in New York on 13 October 1913. The ship's manifest for the first sailing is not available, but the manifest for the 1913 sailing gives the following information:[a]
