Mary Harper Bodigo Oct 27 1836 Age 73 (No other information - Bodigo is the next hamlet to Cross and is only a field or two away from Challow)

Very few Harpers appear after this - did they all emigrate to Canada?

Polgoda - was mentioned in the will - our milkman lives in a place called Polcoda - about 2 and a half miles towards Lanivet which would have backed on to the Trevellion manor estate long a go. There is a cottage just past Trevellion manor called Harper's Cottage - did I mention this before?
