## Marriage Ceremony

---

*Dearly Beloved:- We are gathered together in the sight of God, and in the presence of this company, to join together this man and this woman in the bonds of Holy Matrimony, which is an honorable estate, instituted by God in the time of man's innocency, confirmed by the teachings, and made sacred by the presence of our Blessed Lord, and likened by St. Paul to the mystical union which subsists between Christ and His Church. Marriage should, therefore, be entered upon reverently, discreetly and in the fear of God.*

*Into this holy estate these two persons are come to be joined; therefore, if any man can show any just cause why they may not lawfully be joined together, let him now declare it, or else hereafter forever hold his peace.*

**Hear now what Holy Scripture doth teach  
as regarding the duties of Husbands to their  
Wives and of Wives to their Husbands.**

*“Husbands, love your Wives, even as Christ also loved the Church, and gave Himself for it, that He might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the Word. So ought men to love their Wives as their own bodies. He that loveth his Wife loveth himself. For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother and shall be joined unto his Wife, and they two shall be one flesh.”*

*“Wives, submit yourselves unto your own Husbands as unto the Lord; for the Husband is the head of the Wife, even as Christ is the head of the Church. Let the Wife see that she reverence her Husband.”*

the presence of God, and this company, and  
have confirmed the same by giving and receiv-  
ing a Ring; now, therefore, I pronounce you  
Husband and Wife, in the name of the Father,  
and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost. Amen.*

let not man put asunder.*
