Guy had the most wonderful and fulfilling life professionally, intellectually, surrounded by wonderful friends, family, grandkids, and great grandkids. He travelled the world. He taught me so much about loyalty and family ties, my love of travel and education all came from him. I am so grateful for the 48 years I had with him. He was a pain in the ass sometimes but so was I. We were the most independent of couples..we could travel together or go off on our own. He loved more than anything his fishing trips to Kiipawa with his sons, grandsons and nephews and brothers and his trips back to our second home in Castelnau-le-Lez visiting with the Beguelins where we were planning to go this summer but pneumonia got in the way. He did not suffer and was so brave and only thought of us. He died in Philippe's arms.
